HE12.2 2.2	Problem Solving and Decision Making -- <i>Students demonstrate complete decision making and problem solving processes using evidence to support their judgment and sound rationale to support conclusions.</i>
HE12.3 3.1,3.2,3.3,3.4	Effective Communication -- <i>Students demonstrate effective and complete communication techniques with comprehensive application. They use evidence to support their judgment and a sound rationale to support conclusions.</i>
